Start simple and make it a habit.

Print this file on a printable fabric sheet (follow instructions on product).

Outer dashed line is for cutting and interior dotted line is for pressing under.

Include whatever you know about the quilt and maker on the label. Even if you don't have a full name for the maker, include what you know--surnames, relatives' names, etc. Same for dates and locations: include your best estimate or any other details like when and where you got the quilt.
